WAIVER: Fill out and return immediately

FINAL PREGNANCY REPORT OF VETERINARIAN:

This document is a MUST. Have the vet fill it out after the first pregnancy check or at the end of the season but NO LATER than 31 August. It is the form from which we fill out the breeding report. Without this document returned to Fox Fire no Breeding Certificate can be issued to you. It is essential that the vet report to us any straws in his possession at the end of the season.

STALLION FROZEN SEMEN CONTRACT

This contract, for the _____ breeding season, from _____ to _____, is made and entered into by and between Fox Fire Farm, herein designated *stallion owner/representative*, and _____, mare owner/representative, lessee, or authorized agent, herein designated *mare owner/representative*.

This contract covers the stallion _____, who is registered, approved for breeding and licensed with:

This contract covers the mare _____ (registered name), registered with _____, registration number _____ and born _____, 19 _____, by (Sire) _____, out of (Dam) _____. The service fee is \$ _____, due at the time of signing of this contract.

Mare owner agrees to pay veterinarian for Fox Fire Farm its fee for loading, handling and shipping and agrees to pay all costs of shipment of tank from veterinarian to mare owner and back to veterinarian. These expenses are due prior to shipment of semen. Mare owner (lessee) agrees to pay in advance: 1. Veterinary handling fee, 2. Any courier charges, 3. All fees due to Federal Express or other carrier. Mare owner also agrees to pay any additional charges that may arise including late fees on container.

The sum of \$ _____ is due at the time of signing this contract as a container deposit.
The sum of \$ _____ is due at the time of signing this contract as a deposit on shipping, and courier fees. Any unused portion of the deposit shall be returned by stallion owner/representative to the mare owner/representative provided service fee is paid in full as agreed.

THE MARE OWNER/REPRESENTATIVE AGREES:

1. To pay Fox Fire Farm the breeding fee and handling and shipping costs in full prior to shipment of frozen semen, unless prior arrangements have been made.
2. That mare owner/representative is entitled to up to _____ straws for payment of breeding fee. If additional straws are needed in any one breeding year, the mare owner/representative shall pay the sum of \$ _____ per straw. Stallion owner/representative reserves the right to limit the number of straws sold.
3. To return all unused straws at mare owner's expense, no later than 45 days after insemination.
4. To provide a copy of registration papers of mare at time of signing contract.
5. To have a culture and cytology performed on mare which is free of infection or disease and in sound breeding condition.
6. To complete and return the mare history form and the Breeding Passport to the stallion owner/representative and any other documentation required by stallion owner/representative.
7. To inform the stallion owner/representatives at least five (5) days in advance of ordering frozen semen.
8. To have mare inseminated by a licensed veterinarian.
9. To notify stallion owner/representative in writing not later than 16-20 days after insemination of mare's pregnancy status via ultrasound administered by a licensed veterinarian. Passport is due upon mare **first** being pronounced in foal.
10. That stallion owner is not responsible for accident, illness, disease or death of mare or the foal.
11. To pay all expenses for frozen semen, including handling and transport, shipping and courier fees and any other fees and agrees to reimburse stallion owner/representative any fees within five (5) days of being informed by stallion owner/representative.
12. To assume responsibility for semen container. If container is lost or damaged while in transit to or from mare owner's facility, mare owner/representative shall pay to stallion owner/representative the sum of \$ _____ per container. Container deposit, if

required, is the sum of \$_____. Container must be returned to stallion owner/representative within _____ **DAYS** after arrival at mare owner's facility unless other arrangements have been made. A late fee of \$20.00 per day late will be charged to mare owner/representative.

- 13. To assume responsibility for determining eligibility of mare for inclusion in any registry.
- 14. That failure of mare owner/representative to fulfill the obligations in this contract will void the live foal guarantee (as stated below).
- 15. That no breeding certificate shall be issued without the return of Mare Breeding Passport signed by a licensed veterinarian and indicating the number of straws used. Mare owner/representative agrees to return Mare Breeding Passport to stallion owner/representative by August 30, even if mare(s) have failed to become pregnant. Any fines imposed by breed organizations due to unreturned passport shall be paid by mare owner.
- 16. Mare Owner has paid the breeding fee for one successful pregnancy. Mare owner/breeder agrees that in the event of successful embryo transfer Breeder shall pay the following fees: \$900.00 for first additional implantation after 45 day pregnancy check. \$800.00 for a second additional implantation after 45 day pregnancy check.
- 17. Breeder agrees to pay all invoices at **TIME OF RECEIPT**. Future shipments cannot be guaranteed without invoices being paid.
- 18. Stallion activation fees: If foal is **BORN** from foreign frozen semen and Mare Owner registers foal with AHHA, Mare Owner agrees to pay to the American Holsteiner Horse Association a surcharge of \$125.00 in addition to normal foal registration fees due.

THE STALLION OWNER AGREES:

- 1. That stallion owner/representative will provide viable frozen semen.
- 2. To provide return breeding privileges, if this contract applies to the stallion _____, the following season if mare proves barren or the foal dies before it can stand and nurse, provided proof of such loss, signed by a licensed veterinarian, is presented to stallion owner/representative within ten (10) days of the death of the foal and provided all obligations of mare owner/representative have been fulfilled as maintained in this contract. Stallion owner/representative will supply an equal number of sperm the following year only as return breeding privilege unless this agreement is modified by both parties. Return privileges will not be extended beyond one year without the consent of the stallion owner/representative. Return privileges are cancelled if any of the provisions of this agreement are not met by the mare owner/representative.
- 3. When no return privileges apply, mare owner may purchase extra straws at \$ _____ per straw. Stallion owner/representative retains the right to limit number of straws sold.
- 4. Stallion owner/representative retains the right to refuse to breed the mare owner's mare at any time. Stallion owner/representative will first deduct any costs incurred by the mare owner/representative, then refund any unused portion. Any booking fees are not refundable.

THE STALLION OWNER AND MARE OWNER MUTUALLY AGREE:

- 1. This contract is not valid unless completed and signed in full by both the stallion owner/representative and the mare owner representative.
- 2. Stallion owner/representative and mare owner/representative assume all risks of loss or damage to their own horse (and foal).
- 3. This agreement is not assignable or transferable by mare owner/representative to any other party.
- 4. Substitution of Stallions: Stallion owner/representative cannot guarantee the availability of frozen semen stallions. If any stallion is unavailable, no refund will be made, however, mare owner may choose from any stallion standing at Fox Fire Farm at no additional cost other than the usual shipping, loading, handling costs that are normally incurred.
- 5. This agreement is binding upon the parties, their heirs and assigns and may be amended only in writing by the parties, and is governed by the laws of the state of Washington.

BREEDER'S WAIVER

This waiver is designed for the protection of both the mare owner and the stallion owner/agent. The original should be retained by the mare owner and a copy should be retained by the stallion owner/agent. This document should be executed at the time of booking.

I have read the information in "Instructions to Breeders."

I understand that it is my responsibility to verify the "active" status of the stallion prior to breeding in order to protect my rights to any Association papers or brand for which the resulting foal may be eligible.

I understand that if my mare has not been approved for the AHHA Studbooks at an official AHHA Approvals site, the resulting offspring of this breeding will be ineligible for registration with the AHHA, but would be eligible for a Certificate of Pedigree.

I understand that if my mare is classified as "qualified," any eligibility for, or claims to, registration papers or brand for the offspring of this breeding will be contingent upon my fulfilling the following requirements to the satisfaction of the AHHA:

- 1) Within four (4) weeks (28 days) of the birth of the foal, I am required to send an official Foal/No Foal Report to the AHHA. This report form will be sent to me by the AHHA.
- 2) I am required to furnish adequate documentation (registration and/or other papers and photos) of the identity of this mare as claimed in this waiver at the time of application for registration or certificate of pedigree of her foal. (See AHHA Breeding and Registration Rules.)
- 3) This mare must be presented at an official AHHA Breeding Stock Approval and receive the minimum score required for Studbook entry. At that time, she will also be measured (mares are required to be a minimum of 15'2).
- 4) This mare must be DNA typed. The AHHA reserves the right to Parent Verify any horse prior to Studbook entry.

I understand that if the resulting foal is the product of embryo transfer or frozen semen, DNA typing and parental verification of the foal is required prior to issuance of a Certificate of Registration or a Certificate of Pedigree.

To the best of my knowledge, this mare does does not satisfy the criteria for a "qualified" mare as defined by the AHHA, Inc.

This mare is is not currently entered in the Studbooks of the AHHA.
